Bentley Common Bellringers need your help!

Both St Paul's (Bentley Common) and St Thomas (Navestock) have lovely rings of 6 bells but, sadly, only have 6 trained bellringers as illness and relocation have reduced our ranks. We are trying to keep the bells at both churches ringing but we need more people to learn to ring and join our happy band.

Tuition is free with an accredited tutor and does not require massive strength. Anyone can learn from aged 12yrs and all we ask is you ring for some Sunday services and weddings. Bellringing is also accepted as a skill for the Duke of Edinburgh award scheme and our practices are great fun. We ring at other churches both far and wide and have outings, competitions and courses to improve our skills. We also need someone to help our steeple keeper whose job is to keep the bells in good order. This doesn't need to be a ringer but possibly someone who has an interest in mechanics and simple engineering, but it does require a degree of agility to climb ladders and move around the bells safely.
